BUT WHO PAYS THE BILL?***

Tri Community South EMS will work directly with your insurance agency to seek payment for service rendered. However it is a common practice for these agencies to mail the check to you rather than to the EMS provider. Many people miss this check in the mail or never take the time to forward it to their Emergency Medical Service. This has a devastating effect on our ability to purchase the expensive supplies it takes to continue providing the standard of care you expect.

**After using an ambulance please be looking for an E.O.M.B.
(Explanation Of Medical Benefits)
to arrive in your mail.**

**If this contains a check for Emergency Medical Services rendered,
PLEASE be sure to forward this to Tri Community South.
Also be aware that your insurance agency can include a new policy
number for you that you would be unaware of, should you not be
attentive to their mail.**

**If you are a current subscriber to Tri Community South at the time you
use our service, we will accept what ever the insurance pays, as payment
in full.**
