Parent-Teen Conflict Program helps parents and school-age children in conflict. Any family in Allegheny County with a child between 8 and 18 years of age is eligible.

Most services are free and no one is turned away because of inability to pay.

- Individual and family therapy
- Parenting support groups and parenting education classes
